With more than 100 signatories at the time of its launch, this is the most global and inclusive collaborative action tackling the challenges of climate change within the events industry.

Additionally, Maritz Global Events made the commitment in June 2021 to the UNFCC's Race to Zero Campaign ahead of COP26. - Establish common mechanisms for reporting progress and sharing best practice.

The next step of the Net Zero Carbon Events initiative is to develop the industry-wide roadmap which will support the objectives outlined in the pledge, which is being hosted by the Joint Meetings Industry Council (JMIC) and currently includes over 250 event sector constituents.
